Photocopy of AHA membership cards for owner, trainer, rider, driver, handler

Sale or lease contract (if applicable)

Your check for the full amount

Make sure signatures are included for owner, trainer, riders/handlers, and parents for minors

ENTRY INFORMATION

ENTRIES will not be accepted over the phone. Postdated checks not accepted. Every entry must be accompanied by a valid check or money order for the full amount payable in U.S. dollars. Three entries constitute a class. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes that have not filled, to accept entries for unfilled classes at regular entry fees, and to reject any entry if it seems to be in the best interest of the show.

POST ENTRIES accepted up to the close of the session preceding the post entered class. A post entry of \$5.00 per class charged for classes entered after May 19, 2008.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES: Management agrees to refund entry and stabling fees on any horse not fit to show provided written notice is given on or before May 25, 2008.

After May 25 and prior to Friday, June 6th at 8 am, withdrawal must be accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate.
