EARLY SET UP: Complimentary early set up will be provided by management, for Tuesday June 3rd, and Wednesday June 4th, at no additional charge to exhibitors, as long as no horses are brought on the grounds. Early arrival of horses (prior to Thursday June 5th) is allowed at \$20 per horse per day payable to show management.

BEDDING: Will be supplied by show management. A \$25 shavings and shavings removal fee will be charged per horse. Due to the increase in the cost of shavings we have increased the bedding removal fee to offset the additional cost. We feel this will be a more economical way (over the exhibitor purchasing bagged shavings) to bed stalls.

Stalls will not be bedded when you arrive. It is a violation of Snohomish County Fire Codes to bed aisle of barns with shavings.

RV parking will be handled by the fairgrounds on a first come first serve basis.

AVOID SUPRIZES BY READING THE PRIZE LIST CAREFULLY.

PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING EVERGREEN STATE FAIRGOURND RULES:

- *Stalls many not be altered in any way: fronts and sides may not be removed.**
- *Dogs are not allowed inside the grounds either loose, on a leash or in a kennel.**
- *Lungeing is allowed only in specified arenas. Look for the signs at arenas and in the office.**
- *There are very nice flower beds in front of each barn which are maintained by Snohomish County 4-H clubs. Please do not disturb them in any way.**
