## Early set up

Exhibitors are welcome to set up without horses on Tuesday and Wednesday, June 8, 9, at no additional charge. Early arrival of horses, before June 10, is allowed at \$20 per horse per day, payable to show management.

## Economical bedding!

Shavings will be supplied by show management, with exhibitors responsible for bedding their own stalls. There is a \$30 charge per stall to cover the cost of bedding and its removal. This method is more cost effective than purchasing bagged shavings.

## Please observe these Evergreen State Fairgrounds rules

- Stalls may not be altered in any way; fronts and sides may not be removed. Shavings may not be used in the barn aisles.
- Dogs are not allowed inside the grounds, either loose, on a leash or in a kennel
- Longeing is allowed only in specific areas. Watch for signs on the arenas.
- RV parking is handled by the facility on a first come first serve basis.
